

IMMIGRATION LAWYER POSITION One-Year Contract

The HIV & AIDS Legal Clinic Ontario (HALCO) is a community legal clinic serving the legal needs of people with HIV in Ontario. HALCO provides legal advice and representation, and engages in public legal education, law reform and community development activities. The clinic is seeking a lawyer to provide immigration law services for a one-year contract commencing as soon as possible after the application deadline for this position (see below).

- Work closely with HALCO's other immigration lawyer
- Participate in public legal education, law reform and community development initiatives

Required Qualifications

- Membership in good standing with the Law Society of Upper Canada
- Immigration/refugee law experience (minimum four years)

Preferred Qualifications

- Knowledge of poverty law (e.g., income maintenance, tenancy)
- Knowledge of HIV and affected communities
- Fluency in French
