

## STAFF LAWYER POSITION

The HIV & AIDS Legal Clinic Ontario (HALCO) is a community legal clinic serving the legal needs of people with HIV in Ontario. HALCO staff provide legal advice and representation, and engage in public legal education, law reform and community development activities. The clinic is seeking a lawyer to fill a Staff Lawyer position.

### Responsibilities

The Staff Lawyer will primarily provide advice, referrals, and brief services, but will also carry a small case load. The lawyer will focus largely on income maintenance, tenancy, human rights and other administrative law matters. The lawyer will, over time, have the opportunity to participate in the clinic's public legal education, law reform and community development initiatives.

### Required Qualifications

- Membership in good standing with the Law Society of Upper Canada
- Knowledge of poverty law (e.g., income maintenance, tenancy)
- Experience working with marginalized communities

### Preferred Qualifications

- Knowledge of HIV and affected communities
- Fluency in French
